Ninety-five advisors, representing business and industrial firms throughout the area, will take part in the program. Each JA company will have at least three advisors, one each in sales, production, and management.

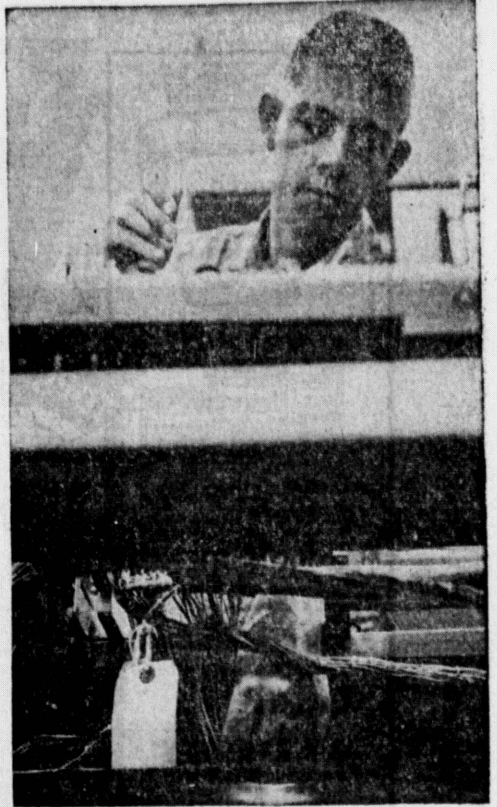
THE TRAINING sessions are preliminary to the organization of the JA companies. The program gets under way at the

The latest progress report on the new information office in Torrance was received this week from R. S. Pyle, manager of Pacific Telephone here.

WIRING HAS been completed, and extensive tests are planned to ensure a smooth operation of the facility.

Thirty-six information opera-

tors will be employed in the office to give local residents dialing information their answers.

Pacific Telephone subscribers in Torrance, Gardena, Wilmington, Lomita, and San Pedro will be served initially from the new office. The western part of Torrance, which receives service from General Telephone Co., will be unaffected.

THE TWO-STORY structure, located at 2154 Torrance Blvd., is currently occupied by Pacific's Torrance business and employment offices.

Applications for operator jobs in Torrance and surrounding cities are still being taken by the company, Pyle said.
