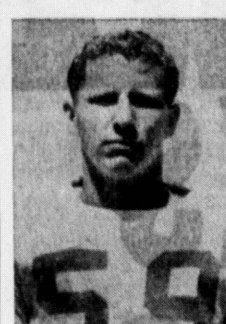

"We are pretty well settled," believes South High pigskin boss Dave Tollefson in referring to his starting eleven.

Long Beach Jordan beckons on Friday, Sept. 28, as the Spartans begin the grid campaign. The following weekend, in a Saturday contest, South will open its South Bay League stand against Leuzinger on the Torrance High field.

It should not be too difficult for the 38 Spartans who reported for workouts to better last year's mark.

SOUTH managed only a 3-5 record and a sixth place finish against rugged Bay League opposition. Only two league teams, Mira Costa and Leuzinger, plus L. B. Jordan fell to SHS.

Lack of weight will prove a definite handicap to the Spartans. The starting team will average approximately 173 pounds with the line averaging

177 pounds and the backs chipping in with 168 pounds apiece.

OPENING ON THE ends for South will be a pair of 6-2

flankers. Phil Dowsing, 175 pounds, and Steve Jongsma, 160 pounds, draw the starting nod.

Another tall-reaching pair, Gregg Maden and John Hestor, have cornered the tackle positions. Madden hits 6-2 and weighs 190 pounds. Hester tips the scales at 205 pounds and stands 6-1.

Occupying the guard berths will be 5-10, 160-pounder Ken Blight and Jim Vosper at 6-0, 175 pounds.

TIM VOETTER, 6-0, 160 pounds, has the quarterbacking pretty much to his own. Assisting in the backfield will be 5-11, 165-pounder Bob Woodrum and Jerry Mann, 5-8, 150 pounds, at the halfback positions.

Dan Ely, 6-0, 195 pounds, will assume the fullbacking chores provided he can shake the injury jinx. Otherwise, Earl Shepherd will take over.

National Drag Champ Vies In Lions Fuel Eliminations

Jack Chrisman, winner of the 1962 National Championships at Indianapolis on Labor Day, will be back at Lions Drag Strip in Long Beach Saturday night.

Chrisman is favored in the gas eliminator event but will

Chrisman will also be entered in the fuel contest and will try to stop Prudhomme's bid for an eighth fuel eliminator title.

TIME TRIALS start at 2:30 p.m. Final eliminations begin at 7:30 p.m.

IF THE CAR is ready by the weekend, Prudhomme will be out and is strongly favored to take the fuel eliminator event.
