## Know Your Traffic Laws

Many times as drivers we fail to realize the importance of making a routine check of our vehicles and correcting any defects found.

We climb into the car and drive away, never thinking of checking to make certain the tail or stop lights are working correctly, or that both beams of the headlights are working.

We drive on the tires until one goes flat or blows out. How many times have you been caught in a sudden rain-storm or in a fog and discovered that your windshield wipers did not work properly, or clean the windshield as they were designed to do.

ROUTINE inspection of your vehicle is not only an important safety factor, but can save you costly repairs while on the road. To check your car as a routine two or three times a week involves only a few minutes but can prevent accidents that would cost you weeks or months in lost time. The cost of correcting a burned out tail light is only a few cents, but the accident a burned out bulb could cause could cost hundreds of dollars.

Merely checking a few critical points of your vehicle regularly, you can do much to lessen the possibility of being involved in an accident. Be-

come a lawful driver, not an awful one.

### SOME SAFETY tips:

- Keep brakes in proper adjustment. A high pedal usually indicates ample brakes.
- Check headlights to see if both high and low beams are working properly.
- Check tail and stop lights, being sure the lens is not broken. At the same time, check to make certain the front and rear turn indicators are working.

• LOOK AT THE windshield wiper blades to see if blade is flexible, then check to see if they clear water from the windshield.

• Check muffler for leaks or broken supports. Leaks are not always visible, but if checked when motor is running, leaks can be detected by sound.

• Check all tires, looking for cracks or worn spots.

• Make certain red beam indicator light on panel is working to indicate when headlights are on high beam.

• It is not enough that your horn works, but it should work every time. Many older cars develop worn horn rings and only work when pressure is applied to one portion of the ring.

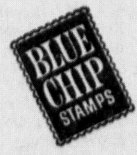
