Board to Canvass Ballots Tuesday

Canvass of the ballots in Tuesday's bond election has been scheduled for 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 25. The Board of Education, following its regular Monday evening meeting this week, adjourned to the Tuesday date "for the purposes of canvassing the bond election returns and conducting other regular business."

Retirement Center Under Construction

A half-million dollar, two-story structure for the elderly is scheduled to be completed in November at 20900 Earl St. Called Spring Manor, it will be Torrance's first retirement center. It will be of French Provincial architecture.

Each of the 35 units will have a private patio or balcony and an intercom system to the front desk, in addition to a large walk-in closet, wall-to-wall carpeting, FM music and fire alarm system. Residences are available completely furnished or unfurnished. Complete maid service will be provided.

PLANS CALL for two large lounges. The ground floor lounge will have a fireplace made of Palos Verdes stone, television and a grand piano, as well as a complete library. A refreshment lounge upstairs will provide a place for guests to entertain visiting friends and relatives. Several galleries, each with private patios, are also planned with the guests' entertaining in mind.

One of the innovations will be furniture custom designed to a higher level than ordinary furnishings which will enable guests to rise from sitting and sleeping positions with greater ease.

SPECIAL SAFETY grab bars will be installed in the bath seat-tubs in each bathroom unit.

A nurse will be on duty 24 hours a day to provide assistance with medication and to assist in case of emergencies.

Spring Manor is located near churches of all faiths and adjacent to shopping centers. The management will provide station wagon transportation for planned excursions and shopping trips.

ALL UNITS are designed to meet modest budgets and will be available on either a month-to-month or lease basis. Reservations for the November opening are now being taken at 370-3594.

Los Angeles Imperial Builders, Inc., are in charge of the construction of the project, with local subcontractors being utilized in various stages of the development. Developer is Don Freeberg of Beverly Hills.
