## Harpichordist Plans Concert at El Camino

Harpichordist Madam Alice Ehlers and Violinist Eudice Shapiro will be featured in a musical concert Friday at 8:30 p.m. in the El Camino College Campus Theater, Hamilton M. Maddaford, assistant director of student personnel, announced this week.

Dr. Alice Ehlers was born in Vienna, Austria, where she received her first musical training at an early age.

She studied piano with Theodore Leschetitzky and harmony and counterpoint with Dr. Karl Weigl. Later she studied harpichord for four years under Wanda Landowska at the Berlin State Academy.

**HER RESEARCH** into early music and the history of old instruments was made under Dr. Curt Sachs and Johannes Wolff. Upon leaving the academy she won the Mendelssohn prize.

In Berlin she had a trio with Paul Hindemith (Viola da amore) and founded the Friends of Old Music, a concert group whose aim it was to bring back unknown and forgotten music of the 17th and 18th Centuries back into the repertoire.

Mme. Ehlers has been professor of music at the University of Southern California, where she teaches harpichord and gives classes in the interpretation of 18th Century music for instrumentalists and vocalists.

**ASKED ABOUT** her life long devotion to music, Madam Ehlers replied, "Why does an artist love to paint? Why does a teacher love to teach? Why does anyone do as he does? It is because he feels a vocation. It is because he has to do it."

Mme. Ehlers said she chose a harpichord for her instrument because she loved Bach's music. It was one of the instruments Bach used and she wanted to play music the way he did. "I wanted to hear the music the way he heard it," she said.

Mme. Ehlers and Miss Shapiro met in 1938, shortly after the former came to California. They decided to become a team because, in Mme Ehlers words, "We understood each

other. We appreciated each others music. We were both very enthusiastic."

**OF HER future plans**, Mme Ehlers declared that she would continue to try to "bring out as many good students as I can."

Violinist Eudice Shapiro grew up in Buffalo, New York, where she studied music with her father, from the ages of 4 to 13. In high school she took lessons at the Eastman School of Music and from there went to the Rochester School of Music. She has also studied at the Curtis Institute in Philadelphia.

She has played at Carnegie Hall, given concerts in most of the cities in Europe and in many of the major cities of the U. S.

**MISS SHAPIRO** chose music because "Music always surrounded me. We were a musical family. My father played violin. I'd guess you would say we had an inborn feeling of music," she said.

Miss Shapiro teaches at USC during the school year and at the Aspen Music School during the summer. She gives recitals when she can, as long as it doesn't interfere with her teaching schedule.

**TEACHING** master classes in New Zealand is listed among one of her most rewarding experiences. "We had a number of truly talented young people. There was much discussion back and forth. It was a very stimulating experience," she said.

Miss Shapiro is married, and her husband is also a musician. She says that her 17-year-old son "is interested in music, but right now he is more interested in science."

Tickets are available in the student book store prior to the Friday night performance and at the box office the evening of the program.
