First Aid Course Set For Area

A Red Cross Standard First Aid course is slated to begin Oct. 4 under the sponsorship of Bonita Street School PTA.

The course will be taught at the school, 21929 Bonita St., in five class sessions on consecutive Thursday mornings from 9:30 to 11 a.m. by Mrs. Scottie Dole, one of the 2,500 certified first aid instructors in Los Angeles County who volunteer their time to make possible this Red Cross service.

"FIRST AID, one of the many areas of training provided as a free service by Red Cross, should be well digested by at least one member of each family," states Mrs. Ross Morris, Bonita PTA president, in explaining why the course is being included in this year's parent education program.

Although specially planned for parents of Bonita school pupils, the free Red Cross course is open to all interested persons.

Hahn in Plea For Approval Of Proposals

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn cites a pressing need for new Juvenile Hall facilities through-out the county.

Passage of Proposition A on the November ballot, a \$17 million bond issue, will relieve the severely overcrowded conditions at the main Juvenile Hall and other institutions, Hahn states.

"Providing facilities, in which erring youngsters and those abandoned and misguided by their parents can be counseled toward a constructive future, is one of the most pressing needs of our county," Hahn said.

The proposition, he further points out, has the backing of the Property Owners Assn. of California.

"By financing these facilities with a bond issue, the cost of the capital investment is spread over a period of years, so that citizens coming to California will also help pay, and present property owners will not be socked with a heavy bill in one lump sum," Supervisor Hahn said.
