"WHEN THE six-year study was launched," Mrs. Millard recalled, "more than 3,000 Los Angeles County volunteers re-Angeles County volunteers responded to the appeal for researchers. The job of each researcher was to enlist 10 families and then record information about them, which is being filed and analyzed in a competely confidential manner over a six-year period.

During the first stages of the epidemiological study—now completed—nearly 70,000 American Cancer Volunteers assisted in the completion of special questionnaires containing over 250 questions and a second shorter questionnaire was filled out last year. This material was sent to the society's national headquarters in New York City, where it was coded and fed to the electronic brains for tabulation.

Dr. E. Cuyler Hammond, American Cancer director of statistical research, is directing the study.

When first results are analyzed, he and other specialists in the field of epidemology believe it may be possible to evolve ways of preventing some forms of cancer. If present rates continue, the disease will prestructure tribe some 45 000 eventually strike some 45,000-000 Americans now living.

ELECTRONIC computers will correlate the association of cancer with inherited characteristics, racial origins, oc-cupation and life habits.

To llustrate the potential of the American Cancer Society study Mrs. Millard cited an historical example of cancer pre-

torical example of cancer prevention.

"Many years ago in England," Mrs. Millard said, "it was found that chimney sweeps frequently developed a certain type of cancer as a result of long exposure of the workers to the soot. As a result, this type of cancer was discovered by studying the frequency of occurance of the disease among gorups of people exposed to a paritcular environmental factor. That's precisely one of the objectives of the present study of the relationship of human living habits to cancer."

THE STUDY, if attempted without American Cancer So-ciety volunteers, would have cost an estimated \$40,000,000.

cost an estimated \$40,000,000. Instead it will cost only a small fraction of this amount.

"Volunteers who make this savings of dollars possible are also saving lives," Mrs. Millard said. "It is through such efforts that cancer will eventually be brought under control."
