

# Alphonzo Bell Wins ACA Endorsement

United States Representative Alphonzo Bell was endorsed today by Americans for Constitutional Action (ACA) in his bid for re-election to the House of Representatives from California's 23rd Congressional District.

ACA is the nationally prominent, non-partisan organization dedicated to the support and preservation of Constitutional government.

# Registration for Sabin Oral Polio Clinics Started

A giant pre-registration campaign for Type I Sabin polio immunization clinics scheduled Oct. 21 and Oct. 28 gets under way this week, the Los Angeles County Medical Assn. announced today.

This phase of the "Sabin on Sundays" (SOS) campaign involves the release of millions of registration forms to the public throughout the County and the Southland. The forms, authorizing the administration of the vaccine, must be signed by all persons being immunized, and brought to the clinics on Sabin Sundays. Minor children must have the forms signed by their parents or guardians.

Following the giving of Type I Sabin Polio Vaccine on Oct. 21 and 28, Type II Vaccine will be given in the six counties in Dec. 2 and 9, and Type III is scheduled for clinics on February 3 and 10.

The giant event will draw more than 5,000 Southlanders, according to Mrs. Myrtle Gilman, 24704 Oak St., Lomita, Dorcas leader. Purpose of the event is to raise funds to help needy persons in Torrance, the local church welfare leader stated.

Mrs. Gilman said the local welfare group will sell needlework items and food in one of 50 specially prepared booths in a giant convention hall at the Lynwood site. More than 50 welfare groups from Seventh-day Adventist churches in Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, Ventura and Kern counties will also participate.

Health and Welfare Service members of the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, 1610 Acacia Avenue, are putting final touches today to needlework and foods which they will sell at a giant welfare rally at 4100 Imperial Hwy., Lynwood, Sunday.

The giant event will draw more than 5,000 Southlanders, according to Mrs. Myrtle Gilman, 24704 Oak St., Lomita, Dorcas leader. Purpose of the event is to raise funds to help needy persons in Torrance, the local church welfare leader stated.

Mrs. Gilman said the local welfare group will sell needlework items and food in one of 50 specially prepared booths in a giant convention hall at the Lynwood site. More than 50 welfare groups from Seventh-day Adventist churches in Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, Ventura and Kern counties will also participate.

NEWSPAPERS throughout the Southland will be running the registration forms until the end of October. Millions of additional forms will be available at doctors' offices, some pharmacies and most food markets. School children will be given forms to take home and in many areas Boy and Girl Scouts will distribute the forms door to door.

The SOS Project is sponsored by the medical associations of Los Angeles, Ventura, San Diego, Orange, Riverside and Imperial counties. Some 1,200 clinics will be set up in schools and other public buildings in practically every neighborhood in the six counties. Los Angeles County alone will have 600 clinics.

Dr. Reginald H. Smart, chairman of the Public Health Committee, Los Angeles County Medical Assn., urged that every family participate in the pre-registration program.

"IT WILL SAVE time at the clinics," Dr. Smart said. "It is necessary to keep a record of everyone who gets the Sabin oral vaccine. Those who have filled out their registration forms in advance will go through the line at the clinics in a couple of minutes."

Sabin oral vaccine is taken by mouth, on a cube of sugar or in a sip of syrup. No hypodermic needle is necessary.

It is hoped that at least 80 per cent of all residents of Southern California will participate in the first Sabin clinics to be held Oct. 21 and Oct. 28. The immunization of such a large percentage of people would greatly help toward the eventual eradication of polio in the Southland.

EVEN THOSE who have taken the Salk immunization series are urged to get the Sabin Oral Vaccine, as added protection. Salk vaccine does not eliminate the polio virus in those who may be unwitting carriers of the disease, but Sabin vaccine can.

All physicians, nurses and lay volunteers staffing the clinics are donating their services. The medical associa-

"THIS YEAR we are hoping to gain funds at this annual event in Lynwood to increase our capability to serve more of those in need in Torrance than ever before," said Mrs. Gilman. "We know the needs locally are greater than ever before; we hope to keep pace with this greater need."

Mrs. Gilman said the 270-member local church welfare society will also take to Lynwood clothing and bedding which will be shipped to Hong Kong to help relieve the desperate needs of refugees from Red China in that city. Foods for needy Navajo Indians in Monument Valley, Utah, will also be taken to the welfare meet by members of the local welfare society. Torrance church members have been bringing in staples and canned goods, which were turned over to the welfare society for this event.

THE DAY-LONG event will open at 9:30 a.m. with a program featuring top church welfare officials, Mrs. Gilman said. At 11 a.m. a large team of medics from the Los Angeles County Medical Assn. will commence a mass Sabin oral polio vaccine clinic at the meet.
