

Changes in Narcotics Laws Recommended by Candidate

"The narcotics problem is one which cannot be minimized in California," Richard Wonder, candidate for assemblyman in the 68th District, said when speaking to the Lomita Property Owners Assn. recently.

"We need tougher penalties for the big time dope peddler and pusher if we are going to lick the problem."

Wonder pointed out, "One way in which law enforcement could be aided in narcotic cases would be the protection of confidential informants. Informants are often members of an addict's family but they are afraid to help the police because of threats and intimidation by pushers."

"Of course this type of legislation would have to take into strict account the constitutional rights of all citizens."

Wonder continued, "Local law enforcement agencies cannot do the job alone. Arrests of pushers are being made every day only to have them reappear after a short prison term, on a parole."

"It is the job of the state legislature to tackle this problem if we are going to protect our children." Wonder stated that he would pledge himself to fight for the kind of legislation that the Lomita property owners were seeking, to control the narcotics problem.

Dills Reports Support for Him Growing

Assemblyman Clayton A. Dills this week was again assured the solid support of all branches of labor in his campaign for re-election.

Among the branches of labor supporting Dills is the powerful California Labor Committee on Political Education (COPE), which is the official political vehicle of the AFL-CIO Unions in the state, as well as the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, Railroad Brotherhood, Teamsters, Longshoremen, Carpenters, Automobile Workers, United Steelworkers, Retail Clerks and Culinary Workers.

Dills has also received the endorsement of business and professional groups. Among the business groups are Southern California Grocers Assn., Retail Hardware Assn., Retail Druggist Assn., Automotive Maintenance and Garage Assn. and the California Federated Institute.

All of the Allied Health Groups, comprised of Dentists, Medical, Opticians, Pharmaceutical, Hospitals, and the Public Health League unanimously endorsed Assemblyman Dills.
