More Cuban Refugees Due in Area

A plane-load of Cuban refugees, under sponsorship of Presbyterian churches throughout the Southland, was scheduled to arrive yesterday at Los Angeles International Airport direct from Miami, Fla.

Approximately 85 men, women and children will make up the group, according to the Rev. Edward R. Danks, chairman of Los Angeles Presbyterian's committee on refugee resettlement.

"This is an emergency program," he said, "being conducted by Church World Service, the relief agency of the National Council of Churches, and known as 'Flights in Freedom'."

Flight leader of the refugees is the Rev. Ernesto S. Sosa, pastor of First Spanish Presbyterian Church of Miami, where most of the refugees have been worshipping since fleeing from Cuba.

"Following their arrival at the airport on Wednesday, which, appropriately, is Reformation Day, the great anniversary of Protestantism, the refugees will be transported by bus to nearby Faith Presbyterian Church, 2057 W. Century Blvd., where they will meet representatives of the churches which are sponsoring them," Rev. Danks declared.

Responsibility of church sponsorship, he pointed out, includes the securing of adequate housing, providing employment opportunities, and assisting the family or individual in getting settled.

Many of the Cubans do not speak English, and the Rev. Ramon Cabrera, pastor of Bethesda Presbyterian Church in Los Angeles, a Spanish-language congregation, will be on hand to help the refugees get acquainted with their sponsors.

Talent on Accordion Recognized
