Three New First Aid Terms Set

Special emphasis on preparedness training has prompted the scheduling of three Standard First Aid courses in

Torrance, according to Walter West, first aid chairman of the Torrance-Lomita Red Cross branch.

Two courses began last Saturday at the First Baptist Church, 2118 W. Carson, with Allen Quignon as the volunteer instructor for both the 9-11 a.m. and the 7-9 p.m. classes.

Mrs. Mabel Davis will teach a Standard First Aid course scheduled on five consecutive Mondays beginning Nov. 12 from 9:30-11:30 a.m. at the Riviera Methodist Church, 375 Palos Verdes Blvd.

THESE, LIKE all Red Cross

courses, are free and open to the public. West says registration is permitted through the second session and may be made at the class.

Students should bring a piece of cloth for bandaging which is at least six inches wide and 36 inches long and 75 cents to cover the charge of the textbook.

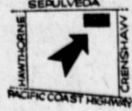
