### Firm Honors Loyal Worker



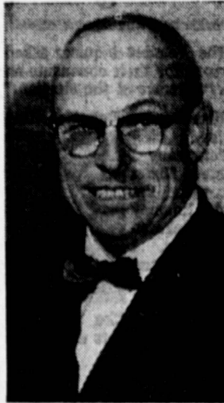

SINCE 1954 Torrance has actively supported the Field Service program and has received a total of 22 foreign students into its three high schools. Torrance students numbering 15 have been sent to European countries as part of the reciprocal program.

The local chapter underwrites \$650 for each student, this is 60 per cent of the actual cost of transporting the student to his foster family.
