## Growth of Religious Freedoms Subject for Television Program

A fast-moving picture history of the development of America's tradition of religious liberty will be featured on a special Thanksgiving release of the "It Is Written" telecast, on KCOP, Channel 13, at 7:30 p.m. Saturday, according to Pastor Manson Metcalf, minister of the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, 1610 Acacia Tve.

The telecast, titled "Freedom Trail," traces the story of how religious oppression and persecution gradually changed to tolerance and finally emerged into the American concept of religious freedom, says Pastor Metcalf.

ON-THE-SPOT motion pictures of scenes where historic battles were fought in the age-old struggle for freedom to worship and believe are included in the half-hour telecast, notes Pastor Metcalf. Narrator George Vandeman recounts stories of famous Americans who jeopardized their lives and fortunes in order to guarantee to their children the right to believe and act according to their consciences.

Believing that Thanksgiving is the time, not only to praise yesterday's pioneers, but also to protect tomorrow's posterity from oppression, Mr. Vandeman cites those developments in today's society which he believes are a hazard to

future freedom, Pastor Metcalf says. COMMENTING on the release of this telecast, Pastor Metcalf commented, "The American tradition of religious freedom today is being threatened by our nation's enemies abroad, it is being eroded by the actions of persons who have too soon forgotten the lessons of history, and it is in danger of being lost by those who care, but are not concerned enough to do something about it."

**TURKEY ROASTING CHART**  
 Set oven at 325. Times are for chilled turkeys, stuffed just before roasting.

Ready to Cook Weight	TIME
6 to 8 Lbs.	3 1/2 to 4 Hrs.
8 to 12 Lbs.	4 to 4 1/2 Hrs.
12 to 16 Lbs.	4 1/2 to 5 1/2 Hrs.
16 to 20 Lbs.	5 1/2 to 7 Hrs.
20 to 24 Lbs.	7 to 8 1/2 Hrs.

Roast to an internal temperature of 185 F. Use meat thermometer. When done, drumstick meat should feel soft and drumsticks move up and down easily.
