To Speak About Crisis in Berlin

Marymount Professor To Speak About Berlin

Dr. Anthony Butkovich, a professor of history and political science at Marymount College, Palos Verdes, will be principal speaker at a meeting of the South Bay Friday Forum to be held Nov. 30 in the Miraleste School Cafeteria, it was announced yesterday.

Dr. Butkovich, a native of Pola, Croatia, in Yugoslavia, will speak on Berlin, one of the focal points of world tension. A film on the same subject will be shown at the meeting.

The instructor, a United States citizen since 1957, witnessed the revolution in Yugoslavia during the years of World War II.

He was graduated from the University of Graz in Austria in 1949 and now holds bachelor of arts, master of arts, doctor of philosophy and doctor of laws degrees.

After arriving in the United States in 1951, Dr. Butkovich toured the nation lecturing on communism and international relations.

Two years ago he traveled around the world, including Russia, on his itinerary, to study the world opinion of the United States and the Soviet Union.

Admission to the Nov. 30 meeting is free, according to officers of the sponsoring South Bay Friday Forum.
