UNLIKE newspapers, how UNLIKE newspapers, how-ever, broadcasting stations do not have the privilege of pre-senting only one side of such issues. By right of their use of public airwaves under a fed-erally granted license, broad-casters have "the affirmative duty generally to encourage and implement the broadcast of all sides of controversial public issues."

This fairness doctrine un-questionably limits many on-the-air editorials to such volatile issues as opposing smog, sin and the San Francisco Giants. On the other hand some stations are doing an in creasingly vigorous job of ex pressing thoughtful opinion
