Three years ago a most compelling newcomer Jacqueline Kennedy, was added to the list of multi-photographed mystery faces the world sees every day but never quite sees beneath. Among others in the elite collection have been Marilyn Monroe, Elizabeth Taylor, Elvis Presley, and General Charles de Gaulle.

I had hoped that "The World of Jacqueline Kennedy" would cast some light across the lovely face of the Sphinx. It did not, but quite likely it came as close to doing so as is possible.

NBC called it "an unposed portrait" and that it was. It was largely a montage of the First Lady without any special footage being made for the program. (One of the major complaints among the reporters covering the distaff side of the White House is Mrs. Kennedy's refusal to grant special press interviews.)

* * *

Some close friends were heard from and their comments were the most illuminating-particularly those of Oleg Cassini. (And who knows a woman better than her couturier?) Quoth Cassini:

"I think there is a lost look there at times, if you want to look very closely. The immensity of her problems appears sometimes in her face and bewilders her. At all times I've had the impresssion with her that you'd better be on your toes.'

Margaret Mead, who is rapidly becoming television's most popular anthropologist (can you name another?),) was also consulted: "She is, you might say if you liked, playing herself, not somebody else, not being an actress playing some part that was written by someone else. She's writing the script herself."

Anonymous: 'She likes people-but one at a time. In conversation you get the feeling she's not talking to

Mrs. Kennedy's own comment on the courtship was taken from old footage: "I met Senator Kennedy at the home of friends who had been shamelessly matchmaking for over a year. Such things don't usually work out."

At times scriptwriter Joe Liss allowed himself to be carried away with such phrases as "global status symbol," "Cleopatra of the Potomac," "a queen in a country that is proud of its democracy," and "The reception given Mrs. Kennedy in Paris was of an emo-tional fervor equal to the Liberation of Paris . . ."

* * *

One of Mrs. Kennedy's comments on child raising might have raised some eyebrows: "I never want the kind of house where you have to say to the children 'Don't Touch!' ". This is only possible if you have servants or if you don't mind footprints on the sofa.

Most of the program showed that the world of Jacqueline Kennedy is a demanding one and that she is quite capable of meeting the demand. It also served to demonstrate to a romantic American public that hers indeed was an enchanted childhood and a story-

For some time there has been concern about television's potential power to sell totalitarianism but surely we have a big head start. The Kennedys have used the medium most efficiently to sell the Administration and, in light of the recent appearance of Ted and wife on the Paar Show, to sell the Kennedys.
