County Fire Engines Getting Resuscitators

Every Los Angeles County fire engine will be resuscitator-equipped by 1964, capping a four-year program.

County Fire Chief Keith Klinger says that 28 resuscitators will be installed this year, and the last 30 are on order.

Since early in 1960, the resuscitators have been added to the equipment of approximately 80 County fire trucks.

SUPERVISOR Kenneth Hahn explained that equipping fire engines with resuscitators converts them into emergency rescue units at a fraction of the cost it would take to provide standard, specialized rescue units.

Value of the units has been proven many times as evidenced by newspaper and television stories relating quick life-saving action by firemen.

The County maintains 20 light rescue units specifically designed for emergency, non-fire calls. In all cases where an engine company is nearer to the call for help than the rescue unit, the resuscitator-equipped engine responds. Therefore, it is possible to provide emergency first aid until the rescue unit is able to arrive on the scene, Hahn explained.

"THIS EQUIPMENT is particularly important in situations where a few moments can mean the difference between life and death, such as in drowning or heart attack cases," Hahn observed.

The supervisor noted that the County Fire Department will be the first major department in the nation completely equipped with resuscitators.

The units will also provide on-the-spot aid for firemen overcome by smoke while fighting fires.

Comparing the cost of resuscitator equipped fire engines (\$500) with that of a special truck and its equipment (\$8,000), Hahn pointed out:

"It would cost over \$2 million to provide a special rescue unit at each fire station. The same results, however, are achieved by adding the resuscitator to the fire engine, thus providing the public with greater protection at a substantial savings to the taxpayers."
