Apartment Under Way

Ground has been broken for a 86-unit garden-type \$750,000 apartment building at 3655 W. Artesia Blvd.

It is expected to be completed in mid-April. Occupying 40,000 square feet, the apartments will feature a large patio area, heated swimming pool, bar-b-que cookout pits for social gatherings, shuffle board and a practice golfing green.

Lewis and Coob of Hawthorne are the designers and engineers for the project and Cal-Prop Investments, also of Hawthorne, are the developers.

THE BUILDING will feature a combination of Pompeii and Renaissance period architecture adapted to modern appointments. Augmenting the Renaissance motif will be several simulated statues of Roman sculpturing to be stationed in garden settings.

Single, one- and two-bedroom apartments will be furnished and highlight individualized decor in each unit. A hi-fi music system will pipe music to all apartments as well as to the patio and recreation areas.

Cabrillo Ups Interest Rate

Cabrillo Savings has boosted the interest paid on savings accounts to 4.80 per cent, effective Jan. 1, it is announced by Pietro di Carlo, president and board chairman of the local association.

The new rate is the highest paid on insured savings, and together with Cabrillo's policy of paying "instant interest" (from the date funds are received), it assures savers of the maximum return available on fully-protected accounts. Interest will be compounded four times yearly.

An increase of over 140 per cent in assets for Cabrillo Savings is reported by Fred Strohenger, executive vice-president and manager. Assets are now over \$6,100,000 compared with the total of \$2,540,000 at the end of 1961. Offices of Cabrillo Savings are in the Rolling Hills Plaza shopping center, Pacific Coast Highway at Crenshaw.
