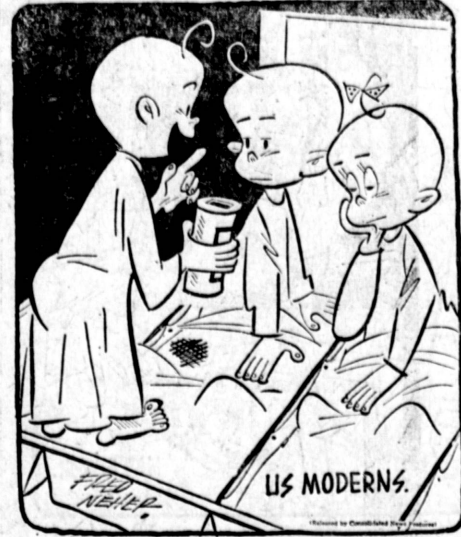

## City Receives Over \$45,000 From Fees

Torrance, with a population of 114,300, received \$45,955.35 in the most recent apportionment of revenue from state motor vehicle license fees, Alan Cranston, state controller, reported today.

The apportionment represents revenue from fees collected from June 1 to Nov. 30, 1962. It is the first and smallest of three apportionments to be made during the 1962-63 fiscal year. Larger distributions will be made in April and June.

CRANSTON SAID there is no state restriction on how cities and counties use the money received, other than the constitutional requirement that it be

used for a general public purpose.

The fees are allocated on the basis of a population formula which in this instance allowed slightly more than 40 cents per capita for cities and slightly more than 31 cents per capita for counties.

IN ACCORDANCE with state law, the counties' shares were based on April 1, 1960 census figures with adjustments to reflect incorporations, annexations and special censuses.

The total apportionment of revenue to California's cities and counties for this period amounted to \$9,753,558. Los Angeles County, with a total population of 5,306,275 received \$2,133,435.88.

## Broadway Appoints Knight Executive at Del Amo

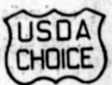
His new appointment as Assistant Store Manager, in charge of merchandising and selling, is effective Feb. 1.
