Since his accident Fontane has dedicated his talent to the recording of sacred music.

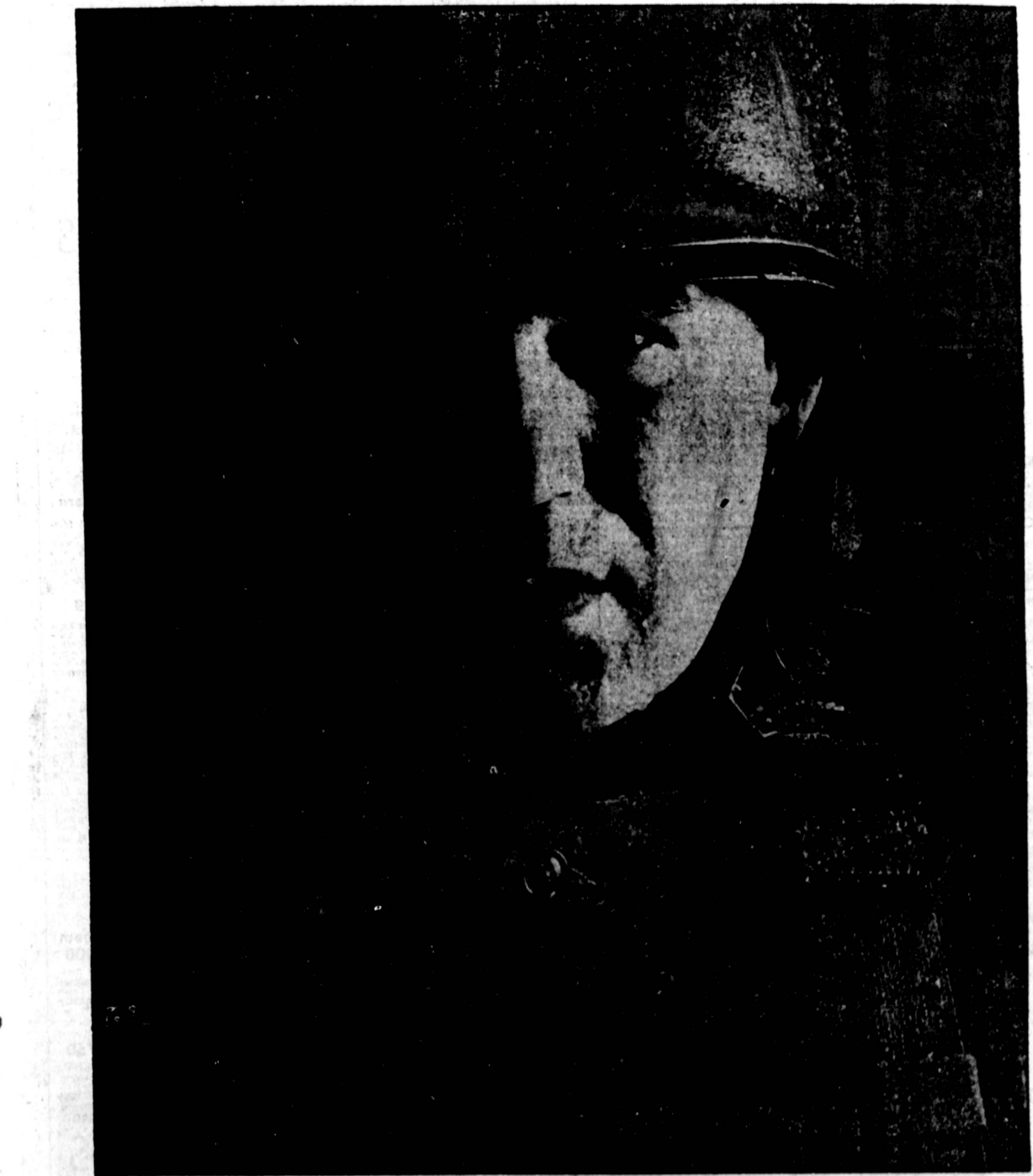
