### Disability Refunds Possible

Persons who worked for two or more employers during 1962 may have had too much de-ducted from their pay checks for disability insurance.

If so, they may be entitled to a refund from the State Department of Employment of anything over \$41 deducted for that purpose. Only requirement is that the deduction must be claimed before June 30.

June 30.

Under state law, employers were required to withhold one per cent of the first \$4,100 paid in wages to each worker during 1962, but in cases where an employe worked for two employers last year, more than the \$41 maximum may have the \$41 maximum may have been deducted from his wages for disability insurance.

THIS MONEY was paid in by the employer to the state or to a voluntary insurance car-rier to pay for temporary in-surance coverage against non-occupational illness or injury.

occupational illness or injury.

More than 235,000 Californians applied for such refunds last year and were paid a total of \$4,699,475 in checks averaging nearly \$20. The excess payment can be refunded only if the worker applies for it on a form obtainable at any Department of Employment field office, or by writing 800 Capitol Ave., Sacramento, Calif.

The amount paid in such refunds is likely to be less in future years since the disability insurance tax limit on wages has been raised from \$4,100 to \$4,600 for calendar year 1963.
