Hollypark Plans Rich Meet

For the eleventh straight year Hollywood Park, the "track of the lakes and flowers" in Inglewood, expects to pay the highest purses in the world, President Mervyn LeRoy said this week in announcing Hollypark's stakes schedule for the thoroughbred racing meet that opens May 9.

There will be 34 stakes for a total of approximately \$1,290,000 added, and about twice this amount will be paid in the "overnight" races, the non-stakes events, making an estimated total of 13,870,000 in prize money for the 55-day season, President LeRoy stated. Heading a schedule of 15

major features for the older handicap stars who will race at the meeting will again be the \$162,100 Hollywood Gold Cup on July 13.

The Hollywood Park stakes program will start on opening day, Thursday, May 9, with the running of the \$20,000 added Hollywood Hollywood Premier Handicap at six furlongs.

THREE-YEAR-OLDS will have 10 stakes in their division, while two-year-olds will have nine.

THREE OTHER RACES will be run for \$100,000 added — The Californian for horses of three years old and upward on June 1, the Hollywood Derby for three-year-olds July 6 and the Hollywood Juvenile Championship, the first hundred-grander in the U.S. this year for two-year-olds, on July 20. The stakes program is the biggest ever offered by a track in the West and will also in-
