The hazards of fog driving were harshly demonstrated in recent widely publicized ac-cidents involving large num-bers of vehicles—but pedes-trians also can learn a lesson from these incidents Califor from these incidents, Califor-nia Highway Patrol Commis-sioner Brandford M. Crittenden said.

"Reduced visibility is one of the pedestrian's greatest ene-mies, not only because the pe-destrian has more difficulty seeing the vehicle, but because the driver has greater difficul-ty seeing the pedestrian. Fog compounds the usual winter hazards of shorter daylight hours and the fact that many persons wear darker apparel. "Even though the production

"Even though the pedestrian has the right of way in a cross-walk, he should not step into the street when a vehicle is approaching until he is certain the driver sees him and can ston stop

"Always cross at intersec-tions, choosing a lighted one where possible. Never step from between parked cars, or cross at mid-block. Outside of a crosswalk, vehicles have the right of way." The commissioned pointed out that the driver also has the responsibility to reduce speed and be additionally cau-tious any time visibility is lowered by darkness or weather conditions.
