# Three Torrance Seniors In Scholarship Judging

Six high school seniors from the Torrance-Los Nietos areas have been named semi-finalists in the Armo Steel Corp.'s 1963 Community Scholarship Plan.

They are: Gerald L. Brady of 2051 W. 235th St., a student at Torrance High School; Richard R. Coulter Jr. of 4806 Paseo de las Tortugas, and Lawrence J. Karr of 5507 Calle de Arboles, both students at South High School; William D. Farwell and Daniel L. Leighton of Whittier and Diane M. Wales of Pico Riviera.

These semi-finalists were selected from a number of area seniors who took a preliminary aptitude test in October. The test is administered for the College Entrance Examination Board by the Educational Testing Service of Princeton, N.Y.

THIS MARKS the fourth year in which Armo has offered a scholarship in the Torrance-Los Nietos areas. The plan was extended here when National Supply became a part of Armo Steel Corp.

Winner of the area scholarship will receive \$650 a year to assist four year of college education. The scholarship is one of 20 which is offered in 14 communities where there are Armo plants.

Brady also was named as a semi-finalist for another award known as the George M. Verity Memorial Scholarship. This award is given to the son or daughter of an Armo employee who ranks highest in the entire national group of semi-finalists. The Verity Scholarship has a value of \$1,000 for the first year and \$750 for each of the remaining three years.

The final winners will be announced in May.
