TV CANDIDS Terrence O'Flaherty

It is a pleasure to announce an occasion when television network thinks boldly in terms of news and public information.

I learn from a New York executive that on Labor Day NBC-TV will cancel three hours of regular programming in prime time to present a comprehensive study of the civil rights issue from the Emanciaption Proclamation to the present.

The program has been under consideration in the higher echelon of the network for several weeks under the direction of William McAndrew, executive vice president of NBC News and the man largely responsible for making the NBC network tops in news and special documentaries during the past two years.

於 如 McAndrews plans to have two discussion periods placed within the three-hour show, which will be composed of leaders in the civil rights movement and its critics. Among them are members of Congress, the Administration, and labor.

Inasmuch as the global press has played the civil rights issue in a big way, NBC newsmen in every major city will join in a study of world reaction to the issue. McAndrew is of the opinion that the story—as well as the problem—is one of the biggest and deserves what is equivalent to "front page space." To do so, he will employ more than half of the network's 800 news department members.

The programs to be canceled to provide time for the special three-hour show are the network's excel-lent "David Brinkley's Journal," its tired "Monday Night Movie' 'and the innocuous Art Linkletter game

The star is Jeffrey Hunter, last seen in the title role of the film "King of Kings." His co-star is Jack Elam, currently playing the menacing marshal in "The Dakotas," which has been canceled.

Goldenson, president of ABC-Paramount, "in order to take fullest advantage on more varied corporate problems of his many capabilities and world-wide experience."
