Students returning to classes in Torrance this fall will receive, in concentrated doses, more education in American economics and in the dangers of communism than ever before in the history of the district.

Elective courses in economics have been available for high school students for the past three years, but economic concepts, American ideals, and teaching about communism are to be incorporated into the required subjects of World Geography, World History, United States History, and United

States Government for high school students.

THE NEW curriculum embraces some 21 basic concepts of economics which are to be included in these courses in a manner which will prevent overlapping and assure students a working knowledge of economics in today's world.

Also being required in the revised courses will be a thorough understanding of communism by means of a study of the various forms of totalitarian governments, the dangers of ideological communism, and the shortcomings

of the economic theories on which those same governments are based. At the same time, the students in the required courses will study fundamental reasons for the strength of American democracy and contrast those strengths with governments under Communist or other totalitarian leadership.

Posner, in charge of instruction for the district, reports that the course in economics has been divided into two semester courses to permit more students to en-

roll. Several courses in business economics and consumer problems will also be available.

Credit for the course revisions and additions belongs to the teachers who worked out the program, and to the great number of Torrance citizens who asked that such courses be included in the instructional program, reports Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools.

"These people, the teachers, and curriculum consultants make an unbeatable team," says Dr. Hull, "and as a result of their efforts, students who are educational products of the district should graduate with a higher economic literacy than ever before."
