Rudolph Harvey Johnson of Torrance is among 15 Southland students scientists who have completed summer assignments as student researchers associated in the California Heart Association's statewide search for gifted minds in the field of biological research.

Johnson, 4114 W. 177th St., worked in the UCLA laboratories where he is a student.

Dr. Sidney S. Sobin, chairman of the California Heart Association's Student Research sub-committee, declared, "The speed with which medical research will advance in years to come depends on finding and recruiting talented young students to enter the field."

Along that line, local Heart Associations donated the 15 \$750 grants supporting the research projects.

She resided at 241 Via Buena Ventura. Mrs. Penny's husband, Ruxton D., told police he was in the living room of their home about 9:30 a.m. Sunday when he heard his wife calling him. He ran into the bedroom and saw his wife lying on a bed with a gunshot wound in her chest and a .22-caliber revolver on the floor, he said.

Mrs. Penny lived in the area 18 years. Survivors include her husband, production manager for Rutherford Electronics, and a sister, Mrs. Thelma LaVerne Cline of Santa Maria.

Services were held by Forest Lawn Mortuary in the Little Church of the Flowers, Mrs. Penny was born in Lushton, Nebraska. The Rev. Frank Richelieu of the Redondo Church of Religious Science officiated. Interment followed in Forest Lawn Memorial Park.

When Polly Watts hinted she would favor the two per cent hike if no other solution could be found, Victor DiBiasi, told the board, "You can't get education at a discount." Charles then changed his vote.

Board members then became involved in a question of who was covered by Shery's motion, and after several minutes of discussion adopted a second motion extending the hike to all employees in the district.

The new salaries will range from about \$5,330 to about \$10,020. The total hike will cost the district \$300,000.

South High Gets Auto Workshop

Trustees of the Torrance Unified School District approved contracts for the installation of equipment in the district's first automotive workshop at their meeting Monday evening.

A bid of \$5,356.75 was awarded to seven firms to the equipment for the new shop. It will be in operation at South High School in September.

The new workshop will be fully equipped for teaching automotive work. Some 47 different types of equipment will be installed in the shop.

A second auto shop will be opened at Torrance High School when the industrial arts-science complex is completed next year.
