three proposed three proposed amendments to
the U.S. Constitution have been drafted, and are receiving wide publicity. The first would en of state Legisiatures. The sec ond would enable amendment
of the national Constitution by action of the several states
alone, without Congressional alone, without Congressional
action, which is now required. The last would set up a "Court
of the Union," made up of the Chief Justices of the state Su-
preme Courts, with authority to preme Cours, with authority to
reverse the top U.S. court.
Under the constitutional provision which permits two-thirds gress to call a convention to consider amendments, these
three proposals have three proposals have been en-
dorsed by five states. A strong dorsed by five states. A strong
effort is being made to get efrort is being made to get
other approvals. This movement is being vigorously op-
posed by the U.S. Supreme Legislators, on the grounds that approval would be a long
step backward in the fight for step backward in
universal equality.

A MOVE to secure endorse-
ment of these proposals by the Conference as a whole started
early, but its supprester took refuge in the complexity of the rules, as opponents dem-
onstrated their strength onstrated their strength.
Simultaneously with the Co ference, an important meeting
of the interstate committee on highway policy problems of the
Council of State Governments was being held in Honolulu. The group worked on problems of interstate agreements on
highway design, constructio highway design, construction
