

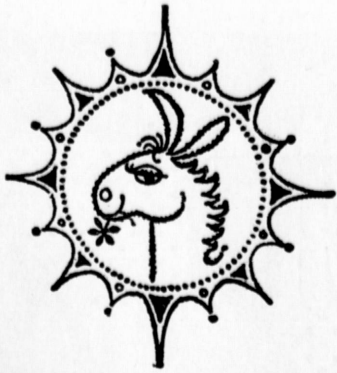
Principals Reassigned To Schools

Five Torrance schools will have new principals when school opens Sept. 11. The changes are a result of several resignations and of policies which change administrators from time to time.

John S. McGee, former Madison principal, will move to Hillside School. McGee is changing places with John W. Strom, who will move from Hillside to Madison.

Edward J. Richardson, former Victor vice principal, becomes principal at Parkway School, and Lee Roy Steffey, a former North High assistant principal, will become principal at Sepulveda School.

Larry K. Miller, former vice principal at Anza, will become principal at Towers School.

Rev. Hiller to Serve as Lutheran School Principal

He studied theology at the Lutheran Theological Seminary in St. Paul, Minn., and has done work at Princeton University.
