where he rated honors in the industrial management program, will coordinate the planning, engineering, site work and construction details of the huge project.

The master plan for the 600-acre community will include approximately 600 ranch-type homes in half-acre to three-acre sites, garden apartments and a village shopping center located at the project's entrance just across Carbon Canyon Road from the new Western Hills Golf and Country Club.

Wilderness Status Given to Minarets

Senator Clair Engle (D-Calif.) announced that the Department of Agriculture has given wilderness status to the rugged spires of the Minarets in the Sierra and Inyo National Forests in California.

Senator Engle said the new Minarets Wilderness is an enlargement and reclassification of the former Mt. Dana-Minarets Primitive Area which was established 32 years ago by the Forest Service.

ENGLE SAID the Department's decision, formulated by Secretary Orville L. Freeman, followed a six-month public notice of the proposed wilderness

and a hearing in Fresno, Feb. 28. At that time the sentiments expressed were five to one in favor of the new Minarets Wilderness as proposed by the Forest Service.

Senator Engle explained that the new wilderness encompasses about 109,500 acres, an increase of about 27,300 acres over the primitive area. Additions were made to include adjacent lands which were predominantly of wilderness value.

THE CALIFORNIA lawmaker said boundary adjustments were also made to exclude water power developments and mineralized lands. One large

hydro-electric power development, authorized by Federal Power Commission prior to the establishment of the primitive area, remains within the wilderness because its exclusion would have resulted in a deep indentation, almost cutting the wilderness in two. It was considered less objectionable to include the power development than to have the deep exclusion into the area.

Grazing of livestock will continue in the area. The U.S. mining laws will apply. Hunting and fishing will be permitted under the regulations of the State Fish and Game Department.
