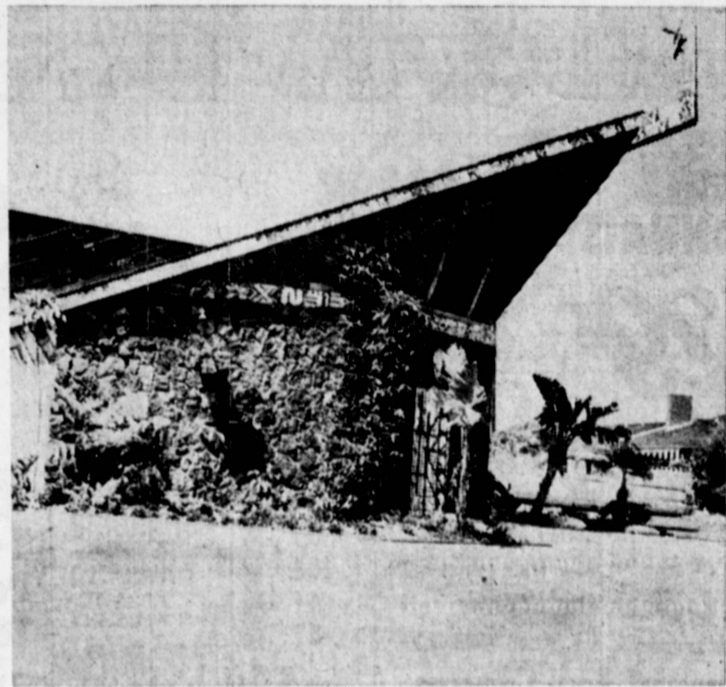

## Red Nichols Opening at Marineland

Red Nichols and his golden cornet were welcomed back to Marineland Restaurant this week when he and his band, the Five Pennies, opened in the cliffside restaurant's "Porpoise Room."

One of the most enduring musical institutions in America, Nichols was greeted by his fans who still remember his horn in the '20's. Also on hand were newer generations of hand-clapping, foot-tapping fans dressed in the Five Pennies style.

Owner-host George M. Foster, who has signed the musical idiot every year, reported reservations are going fast. The group plays nightly except Mondays.

Nichols is recognized as one of the greatest cornet players, and his fame grew out of his immortal recording of "Ida, Sweet as Apple Cider." His hit 1959 album was recorded at Marineland while his life story was being filmed in Hollywood.

The musical group, appearing here for the sixth time, will be at Marineland through October.

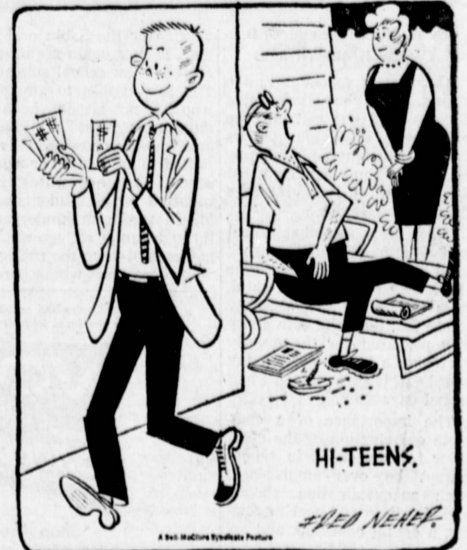
