Hahn Convention Center Plans Backed by Noted Traffic Expert

Full support of a program spearheaded by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn to build the world's finest Exhibition and Convention Hall in Exposition Park was offered this week by Ralph T. Dorsey, Manhattan Beach City Councilman and former traffic engineer for the city of Los Angeles.

Councilman Dorsey, who last year served as mayor of Manhattan Beach, wrote Hahn: "You should, along with the Board, be commended for con-

sidering the site in the vicinity of the Coliseum for many reasons."

HE ALSO commended the Supervisor for "wise action" in development of the Sports Arena, built at no cost to the taxpayer through, self-retiring revenue bonds.

In 1955, Hahn, as Coliseum Commission president, led a drive to obtain legislation in Sacramento permitting gate receipts to pay off the \$7.8 million in Sports Arena construction bonds.

He is now chairman of a special committee of the Commission which proposes construction of the huge exhibition center adjacent to the Sports Arena.

"The combined area would make the new center the largest of its kind in the world," Hahn said.

"Through revenue bonds, it could be built for the enjoyment of the public but not cost them a dollar," he added.
