

"Man's time limit for exercising sovereignty over the earth has nearly expired and God's resumption of full control will soon be seen," Nathan H. Knorr, president of the Watch Tower Society, told Jehovah's Witnesses at the windup sesion of the eight-day "Everlasting Good News" Assembly which concluded Sunday at the Rose Bowl.

Local Witnesses were among the 118,447 convention delegates and visitors who heard Knorr delive the highlight address of the convention, "When God Is King over All the Earth."

Knorr pointed out how men's efforts to establish ideal governments have failed. He cited as evidence skyrocketing costs of government on all levels, labor problems, population explosion, food shortages and fear of nuclear war.
