

### German-Born Teacher Joins Lutheran Elementary Staff

A German teacher who came to the United States "to learn English" has been added to the staff of the First Lutheran Elementary School here as a third grade teacher, it was announced this week.

Doris Menzel, a native of Gilsenkirchen, Germany, attended schools in Berghamen and seminary for teachers in Hamm. She has earned a German degree to teach arts and crafts at elementary and high school levels as well as a degree to teach primary grades.

MISS MENZEL taught for five years in a German Lutheran kindergarten before coming to the United States. In addition to her teaching duties she completed a course in puppetry in her native country.

The teacher came to the United States on the invitation of a professor of Grove College in Pennsylvania and his family, and enjoyed her stay so well she has decided to become a resident here.

For two years, she has been teaching first and second

grades at a Christian day school in suburban New York.

"I HAVE enjoyed my trip by car from New York state to the West Coast," she said on her arrival here. "I have no words to describe the sunrise at Grand Canyon."

"I have been in Torrance only a few days and I find the people very friendly. I am looking forward to teaching at the First Lutheran School in Torrance."
