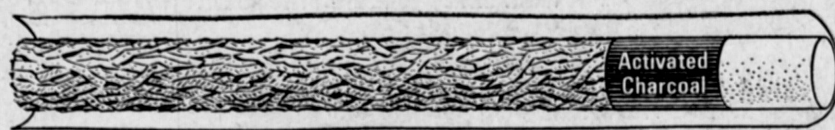
Admission will be by tickets, issued without charge, at the May Co. and the Hayden, Stone and Co., office.
