

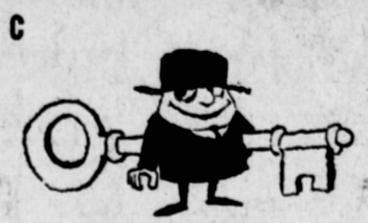

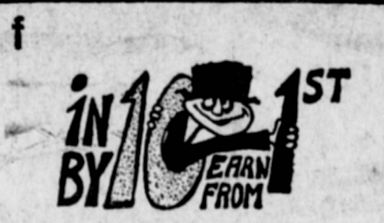

## Alliance, U.N. Topic For Forum

Torrance League of Women Voters will sponsor an open meeting at Jefferson Elementary School next Tuesday on the United Nations and the Alliance for Progress. The meeting will begin at 7:45 p.m., and will be followed by a question period.

Dr. Aurelius Morgner and Mrs. Robert Neumann will be the featured speakers at the meeting. Mrs. Albert Nadel will serve as moderator.

Dr. Morgner is head of the department of economics at the School of International Relations at the University of Southern California. He is a specialist on the Brazilian economy and has taught as a visiting professor at the Escola de Sociologia, Universidade de Sao Paulo, in Brazil.

HE HAS recently returned from trips in Latin America, and has spent the last two years studying the effects of the Alliance for Progress. He has taught at Texas A & M College, Northwestern University, and the University of Minnesota. In addition Dr. Morgner has taught in the European program of the University of Maryland.

Mrs. Neumann, who was born in India of American parents, is the California director for the United Nations study of the League of Women Voters. She was graduated from Rollins College and from Yale University. She has attended the Geneva School of International Relations and studied in France.

A founding member of the League in Oshkosh, Wis., Mrs. Neumann has served in numerous positions on the League's board of directors.

SHE IS a member of Chi Omega Sorority. Her husband is the director of the Institute of International and Foreign Studies at UCLA, and a member of the Policy Planning Board of the Department of State.

Following the formal presentations, there will be a question period. The meeting is open to the public at no charge. Jefferson School is located at 21717 Talisman St.

Mrs. C. R. Berwanger, president of the Torrance League of Women Voters, said "The League has had a deep interest in the United Nations since its inception. We appreciate its value as a constructive force in our age of political, economic, and social discord. We have also realized the importance of the foreign economic policy of the United States in dealing with some of these problems. I am extremely pleased that we will have the opportunity to present two such well qualified speakers in these subjects."

HALE CHAMPION, a member of the board and state finance director, said that no site has been found that is completely satisfactory. He seemed to indicate that some compromise will have to be made. Some members of the board have also suggested that additional monies for the site will have to be made available by the state legislature.

A study of land costs in the Peninsula and the Torrance survey will be presented to the board as soon as possible. A final decision—anticipated for some 18 months—will probably not be made before the end of the year.
