Baptist Temple Notes Birthday

Worship services which began eight years ago at the YWCA building at Carson Street and Plaza Del Amo with the Rev. and Mrs. Joseph Morton and their two daughters, Patsy and Sharron, the only ones in attendance will celebrate an anniversary this week with a membership of 234 persons.

From that first meeting on Oct. 2, 1955, the Torrance Baptist Temple emerged from the mission church stage on Jan. 20, 1957, as a chartered church with 23 members. The present site at 2077 W. 236th St. was acquired shortly after this time and a building program begun under the direction of the Rev. Mr. Morton.

FIRST improvement on the new property was a modest library building which was converted into a sanctuary. It was followed soon with a 14-room Sunday School plant. The plant can now accommodate 200 in Sunday School.

Since its founding eight years ago, the church has arrived at a point where it now supports in part seven different missionary families on seven different fields. During recent years, the mission program has been increased each year and the outlook is to continue to increase it, the Rev. Mr. Morton reports.

AMONG THE principal projects of the young church is the contribution toward support of the Baptist Bible College in Springfield, Mo. Funds to build a chapel in India for use of one of the mission families also was raised during a recent Mission Conference in which the church participated.

The Rev. Mr. Morton invites "great things for the future of the church in the fast-growing south Torrance area."

THE PASTOR, who came to California 17 years ago, has been in the ministry for 12 years, and has been responsible for the establishment of several churches during that period.

A special anniversary service has been scheduled for 8 p.m. Sunday at the church. Earlier a church picnic will be held in Torrance Park.
