RESOLUTION NO. 63-246
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE DECLARING THE INTERESTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF 228th STREET BETWEEN SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD AND THE ATCHISON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY RIGHT OF WAY AND THE CITY OF TORRANCE FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREON AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS RESOLUTION.
WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to vacate a portion of 228th Street between Sepulveda Boulevard and the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company right of way within the City of Torrance, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Southern line of 228th Street, 33 feet wide, with a line that is parallel with and North of the center line of Sepulveda Boulevard as shown on County Survey Map No. C.S.B. 312, Pages 1 and 2, on file in the Office of the Los Angeles County Surveyor, and extending along said Southern line to the Northeast corner of that certain parcel owned and described as Deed to the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, right of way, File 241 of Official Records on file in the Office of the County Recorder of the City of Torrance, and thence Northwesterly along said Northwesterly prolongation of the Northern line of said 228th Street; thence Westerly along said Northern line to aforementioned parallel line; thence Easterly and Southeasterly along said parallel line to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of said proposed vacation the City Council elects to proceed under the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941 of the State of California (Chapter 250, Statutes of 1941) as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.
The City Council hereby declares its intention to vacate a portion of 228th Street between Sepulveda Boulevard and the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company right of way as more particularly shown upon a map bearing the legend "Map showing the proposed vacation of a portion of 228th Street between Sepulveda and the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company Right of Way in the City of Torrance, California," which map is on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Torrance and marked "Filed September 16, 1963," and which map hereby referred to for particularities as to the proposed vacation.

SECTION 2.
The 15th day of October 1963, at 5:30 p.m. of said day, in the Council Chamber of the City of Torrance, California, in the time and place fixed for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

SECTION 3.
The City of Torrance does reserve and except from the vacation a permanent easement with the right at any time to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraph and telephone lines and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, and water, including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable material and wooded growth, and otherwise protect the same from all hazards, upon and over the Northernly 16.5 feet of said 228th Street proposed to be vacated.

SECTION 4.
The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a copy of this resolution in the Torrance Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City one time at least ten days prior to the date of said hearing.

SECTION 5.
The City Engineer is hereby directed to post conspicuously and less than four copies of this resolution not more than one hundred feet apart upon the boundaries of said land to be vacated.
