Fall Schedules Outlined For Parks and Playgrounds

Fall schedules for Torrance Parks and playgrounds have been established by the Torrance Recreation Department. During open hours, the parks will have supervised activities and will feature a varied program of arts and crafts, sports and games, and special events.

Individual programs may be obtained for the local areas. The following parks will have supervised activities:

- Torrance Park, 2001 Santa Fe: Monday-Thursday, 3:30-8 p.m.; Friday, 3:30-5:30 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
- El Retiro Park, 126 Vista del Parque, and Paradise Park, 5006 Lee St: Monday-Friday, 3:30-5:30 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
- La Romeria Park, 19501 Inglewood Ave.: Monday-Friday, 3:30-8 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
- McMaster Park, 3624 W. Artesia Blvd.: Monday, 4-9 p.m.; Tuesday-Friday, noon-9 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
- Walteria Park, 3855 242nd St.: Monday-Friday, 3:30-9 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.

In addition to the parks, several school playgrounds will be open each Monday through Friday from 3:30 to 5 p.m. for supervised activities. They include:

Arlington, Flavian, Hickory, Hillside, Jefferson, Madrona, Newton, Parkway, Perry, Riviera, and Victor schools. Lincoln will be open Tuesday and Thursday, while Seaside will have supervisors on duty Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

All the school playgrounds will be open on Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Hospitals Use 4,769 Pints Blood in Year

Red Cross distributed a total of 4,769 pints of whole blood to Torrance hospitals from June 30, 1962 to June 30, 1963, plus plasma and derivatives, according to Mrs. Robert Orsini, chairman for the Torrance - Lomita Red Cross branch.

Harbor General Hospital acquired 3,611 pints of whole blood from the Red Cross; the Riviera, 428 pints; Little Company of Mary, 412 pints; and Torrance Memorial, 320.

Mrs. Orsini, stressing the need for donor support on a continual basis, stated, "For transfusion purposes whole blood lasts only 21 days, and Red Cross must have a continual supply."

In addition to the periodic visits of bloodmobiles to communities and industrial plants, the regional blood center, 1130 S. Vermont, Los Angeles, is open from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:30 to 5:30 p.m. on Friday.

The next public bloodmobile for this community will be held Nov. 11, at the Elks Lodge, 1620 Abalone, 2:30 to 7 p.m. Appointments should be made by calling Red Cross at TE 2-8321 or FA 8-0510.
