

# Spartans To Engage Seahawks

Tomorrow night could mark the end of a season-long South High football losing streak. After putting forth its finest effort of the year last week in a 13-6 loss to Hawthorne, South will tangle with defense-minded Redondo at 8 p.m. in a Bay League fray tomorrow on the Seahawk field.

South fell to Hawthorne last week only when halfback Doug Kinn blasted 80 yards for a touchdown in the final quarter. The Spartans had Hawthorne backed down to its five yard line before a face-mask penalty pulled the Cougars out of danger.

THREE HIGHLY successful games ended for Redondo last week when league favorite Santa Monica claimed a 33-9 triumph. Three long passes and overall speed were too much for the Seahawks.

Defense had been Redondo's strong point up to the Samohi game but the Vikings managed to grind out 194 yards on the ground.

EVEN IN defeat, reliable Redondo tackle Nick Carollo stood out. After the game, Santa Monica coach Don Kramer moaned about his team's inability to run the fullback trap through Carollo's position.

"We could not run our fullback trap once all night. He just kept jamming them up in there," Kramer complained.

LACK OF A sound defensive secondary has been South's problem all year long, according to Spartan boss Dave Tollefson.

"When they get to our secondary, they are just gone," Tollefson explained. Despite his club's five straight defeats, Tollefson claims South will be in there at the finish with Redondo.

# Upstart Lawndale Meets Torrance

Two pigskin squads who were both involved in contests with surprise endings last week will meet head on tomorrow night in a Pioneer League contest at Torrance High.

Lawndale, jubilant after earning a deadlock with arch-rival Aviation, and Torrance, smarting from a surprise defeat at the hands of Lennox, will tangle at 8 p.m. in the second round of league competition.

Deceptive Lennox came alive in the third quarter last week to register 13 points and forge a 27-20 decision over the Tartars. Quarterback Greg Barrett and Rene Ponce teamed for two touchdown passes to no avail as Torrance remained winless.

LAWNDALE'S evening was considerably more successful as the Cardinals notched a 13-13 deadlock with Aviation. Pre-season title pick for the Pioneer crown.

The Cardinals romped home by bunching 13 points in a wild second quarter and then staving off a last half Aviation comeback. Senior quarterback Rick Heath was the difference.

HEATH capped one 70-yard Cardinal march by diving across from inches out. Heath's TD ended a jaunt that consumed 6 minutes and took 15 plays.

Joe Burton, Aviation's top man and the area's leading scorer, was indirectly responsible for the second Lawndale score. Burton fumbled on his own 25-yard stripe and the Cards recovered.

Unable to move on the ground, Heath tossed a 17-yard bomb to end Bill Lietzel that gave Lawndale a 13-0 lead at halftime. Even then the Cards were not through, marching down to the Aviation 30 late in the game before faltering.

# EC Looks Ahead to Crucial

Warming up for its biggest athletic battle since 1954, El Camino College will host sturdy San Diego Saturday night in a Metropolitan Conference clash.

Undefeated and ranked as one of the top junior college elevens in the nation, El Camino has only one week remaining before traveling North to meet another unbeaten team, Bakersfield.

Should the Warriors let down on Saturday, the game with Bakersfield could lose considerable importance since San Diego is fully capable of pulling the rug from under Camino.

CERRITOS, a 23-12 loser to El Camino, managed a 29-20 win over the Knights last week. San Diego will open with freshman Nate Shaw at quar-

terback. In a game against Harbor College, Shaw completed 7 of 12 passes for 65 yards and two touchdowns.

ON THE ground, the Knights will go with Rich McClendon, a 1961 letterman who tore through the Cerritos defense for two touchdowns on runs of 65 and 25 yards. He has been averaging close to six yards per carry.

El Camino will be coming off a 54-6 rout of East Los Angeles. Sparking the second most prolific pigskin night in El Camino history, former North High sensation Daryl Wilson charged to 119 yards in the first quarter and wound up with three touchdowns for his evening's work.

CAMINO ROLLED to a total offense figure of 449 yards

while East Los Angeles could manage only 98 net yards. The Bakersfield contest will be reminiscent of the 1954 battle when the two elevens, both undefeated, met Thanksgiving Day on the El Camino turf. The Warriors picked up a 30-19 win which gave them a bid to the Junior Rose Bowl.
