Pupils attending Los Angeles City Schools in this area were reminded this week that they must complete their polio immunization if they were admitted to school without full immunization.  
 The law provides pupils may be admitted to classes if they complete their immunization series within 60 days. The deadline for immunization is Nov. 18.  
 Immunization may be completed at county health department centers or by the family physician. School doctors and

nurses are not permitted to immunize pupils.  
 Failure to complete the immunization series may result in denial of attendance at school until the provision of the law are met.

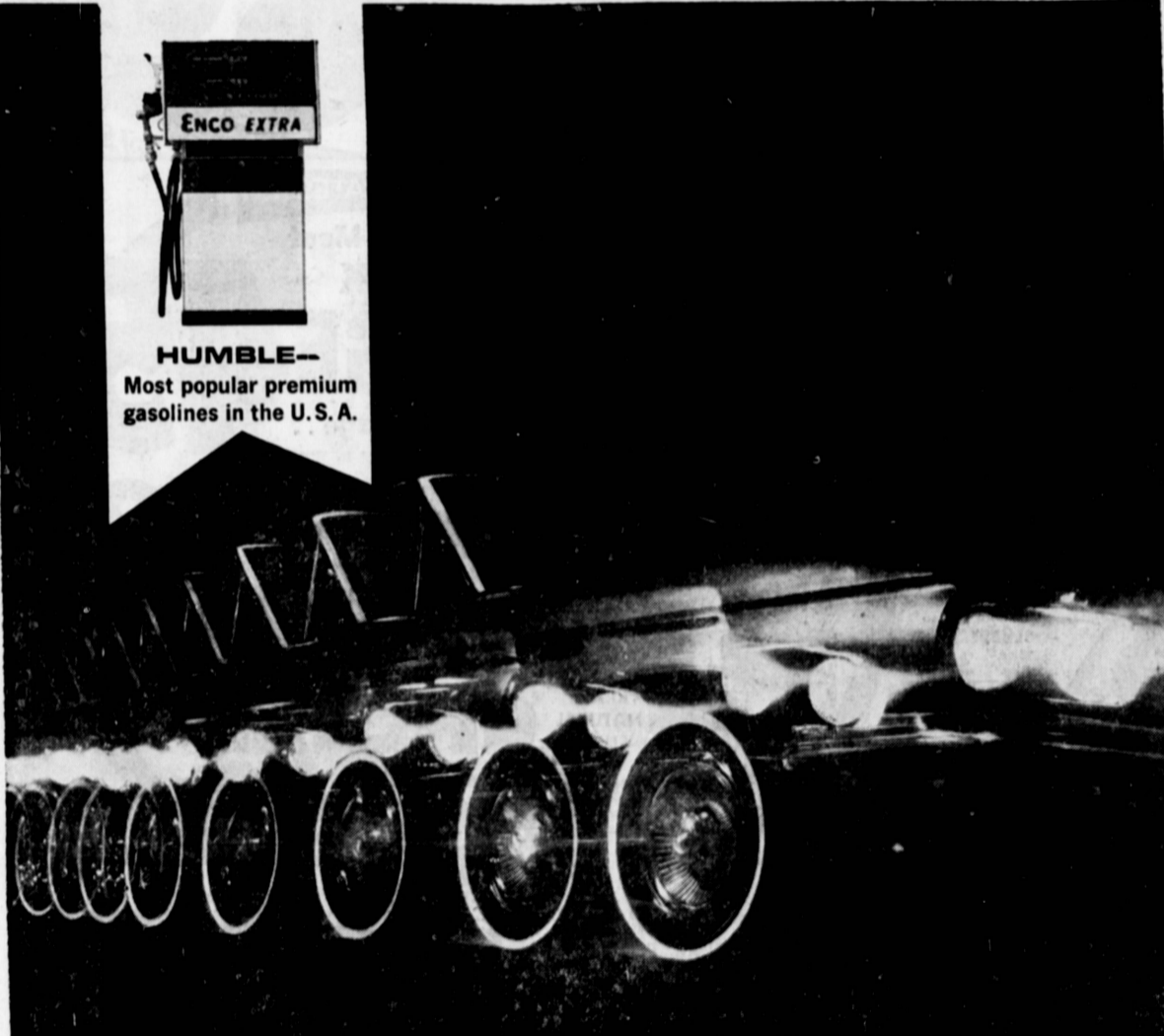
