have been approved by the Board of Supervisors. Known as Unit 1-D of the
project, the job is expected to cost about $\$ 375,000$. It i
designed to prevent contamdesigned to prevent contam
ination of fresh water by sea
water. water. Bids for the project will b
opened Dec. 13. The contract is expected to be awarde about 10 days later. The project includes the
drilling of 19 recharge driting of 19 recharge wells
within the dedicated street right-of-way on Prospect Avenue. The 19 wells, to be
drilled on Prospect between drilled on Prospect betwee
Anita Street and Spence
Street, will be 32 inches diameter and 600 to 700 fee deep. Unit 1 of the project is now under construction. It includes
12 wells between Spencer Street and Torrance Boulevara
in Redondo Beach. The barrier, involving 82 wells
an 11-mile stretch of coastline will be finished by 1966.
