Clinic hours have been extended from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. The painless tests are designed for all age groups and takes only a few minutes.

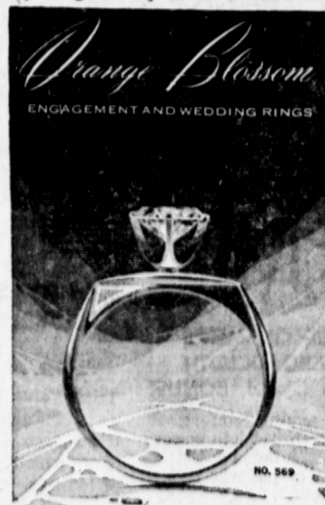
Mrs. Frank C. Hencel, chairman of this community service, said last year's final count showed the Harbor City clinic

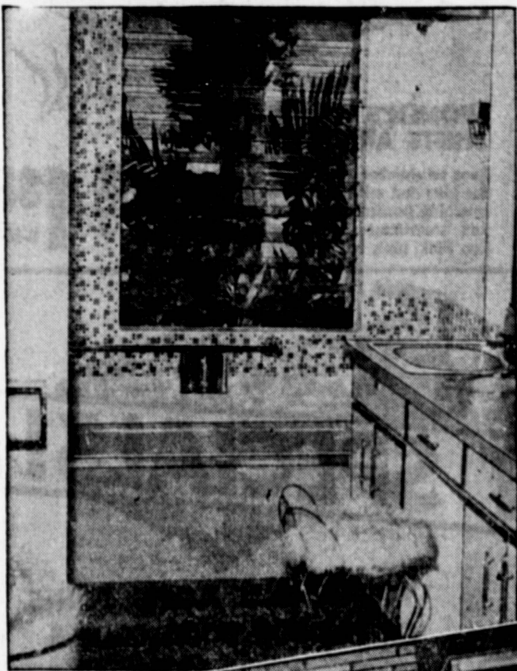

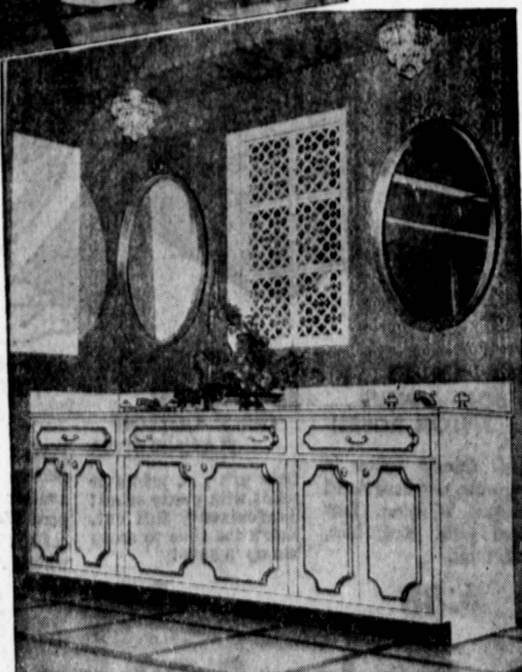
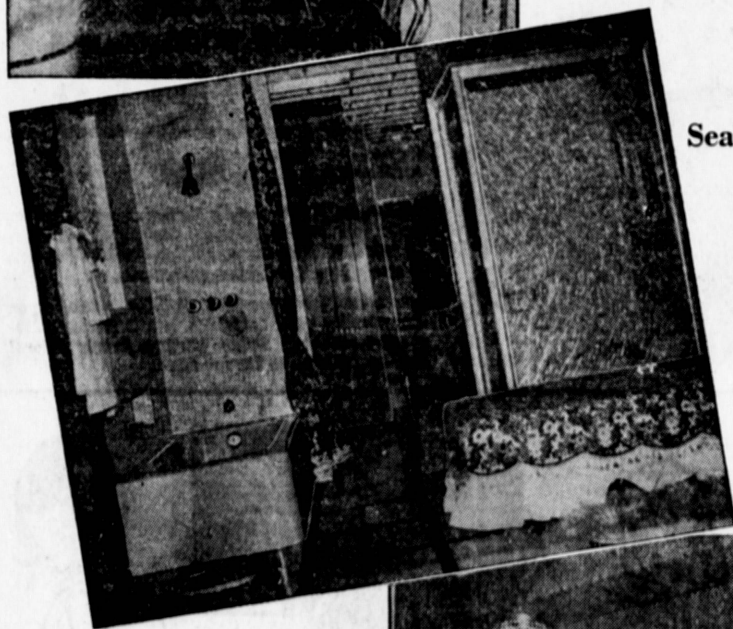
