Three Southland people were made richer this week at the conclusion of the MG Sports Sedan Freeway Enduro. During the past three weeks, more than 50 MG dealers in Southern California have been accepting entry forms with estimates of the total distance traveled by four MG Sports Sedans for the full week from 2 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, March 22, through 2 o'clock in the afternoon of March 29.

When the cars came in on their final runs, Pat Ahern and Matthew Nottoson of the Nisonger Corp., representatives for the speedometer manufacturer, unsealed the speedometers and certified the total mileage.
