In general, most individuals regard measles quite lightly, and parents are often glad to have their children contract the disease in order to get it over with. But even though in the majority of cases measles may be nothing more than a distressing illness of relatively short duration, doctors consider it a treacherous ailment since complications, particular-ly pneumonia and measles en-cephalitis (brain inflammation), are not uncommon and are ex-ceedingly dangerous.

TWO TYPES of vaccine will be used in measles control and be used in measles control and these, as in the polio vaccines, consist of an attenuated (weakened) live measles virus vaccine—and an inactivated (killed) virus product. The live virus vaccine is the only one presently available but is in short supply. The other will be marketed within a few weeks.

The live virus measles vaccine in the product of t

The live virus measles vac-cine, unlike the Sabin live virus oral vaccine, will not be given by mouth. Both measles vaccines will be administered by injection.

ONLY ONE injection of the live virus measles vaccine is needed for complete protection against the disease, whereas three of the killed virus type, administered at monthly inter-vals, will be required to pro-duce an effective immunity. It duce an effective immunity it has not yet been positively de-termined as to which vaccine offers the best protection or how long-lasting the conferred immunity of each will be. Nevertheless, in the opinion

of some research workers the live virus measles vaccine pro-duces a faster and a greater duces a faster and a greater protection against the disease. However, it is known that this type of vaccine may produce some unpleasant side effects, including fever and rash, that resemble the symptoms of illness that are induced by a mild attack of the disease. These effects it is stated, can usually be minimized by an accompanying does of gamma globuling. dose of gamma globulin, a blood derivitive, or by two in-jections of inactivated vaccine followed by one injection of the live virus vaccine. BECAUSE OF these unto-ward side effects, however, a recommendation was recently issued by the U. S. Surgeon General, Luther L. Terry, to the effect that the live type of measles vaccine should be withheld from pregnant wom-en, leukemia patients and cer-

tain other groups.

Since the measles vaccine is Since the measles vaccine is needed chiefly by children under six, particularly in the second and fourth years of life when the incidence of the disease is usually highest, no mass vaccination program against measles is planned by health officials. When the measles vaccines become widely available, however, it is recommend that children between the ages of 9 months and six years be vaccinated unless they have had the disease. One attack of measles generally confers a life-long immunity. The development of a meas-
