Thrifty Drug Honored By Veterans Committee

Thrifty Drug Store Co. this week received the highest award of merit from the State Veterans Employment Committee, and was the only retail sales organization in California to be so honored, according to Irwin J. Kaplan, chairman of the committee.

The award is in recognition of Thrifty's long-standing policy of preferential hiring of veterans, Kaplan said, and was presented by Arthur Morgan, area manager of Metropolitan Los Angeles of the California State Department of Employment. Also participating in the ceremony, held in the department's Los Angeles headquarters, were representatives of the U. S. Department of Labor and officials of veterans' organizations.

GLENN BISHOP, personnel director of Thrifty Drug Stores, who accepted the award on behalf of his company, said that over 73 per cent of his company's executives and managers are veterans, and that more than 66 per cent of the men currently enrolled in Thrifty's management training school are veterans or in Reserve status.

"Because of their veteran status," Bishop said, "These men have learned to exercise authority and to accept discipline. In addition, many of them received extra education under the GI Bill, and they comprise an exceptionally well-qualified group of employees."

THE VETERANS Employment Committee, that voted the award to Thrifty, is composed of state commanders of AMVETS, the American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, Fleet Reserve Assn., Jewish War Veterans, Military Order of the Purple Heart, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and Veterans of World War I; representatives of nine government agencies serving veterans, and 26 additional members appointed by the director of the State Department of Employment.
