Senator Cites Basic Flaw In Assessing Castro's Cuba

Senator Clair Engle (D-Calif.) said today that a "fundamental flaw" in U.S. Cuban intelligence prior to the October crisis of last year was the assumption that Soviet strategy would never call for offensive missiles in Cuba.

"This erroneous assumption was pointed out in the report issued recently by the Senate Preparedness Subcommittee," Senator Engle said.

"The Subcommittee, I believe, was thorough, fair and objective in analyzing the Cuban military buildup. They demonstrated that on the whole the intelligence operation of this country turned in a creditable job.
