NATURE'S ALLIES — Experts agree that raising an animal is far easier if you go along with natural instincts rather than try to make it do things your way. Accordingly, scientists at the Cargill-Nutrana reach fare is Minne. scientists at the Cargill-Nu-trena research farm in Minne-sota began working five years ago to devise a new swine pro-duction system.
