## Principal Wins Degree

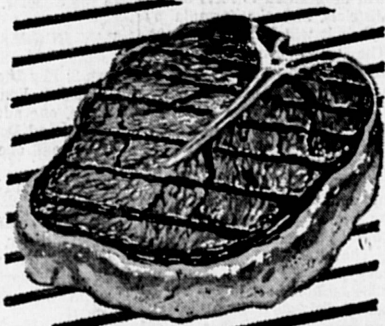
