Wing Aircraft Markets New Twin-Engine Plane

Wing Aircraft Co., a division of the Hi-Shear Corp., has announced plans for production of a new twin-engine aircraft. The new plane, named for a famous compact pistol, will be called the "Derringer."

Production on the new aircraft will begin at the Okmulgee, Okla., plant as soon as the advance test models have been certified. The prototypes are currently in advanced stages of construction at the Torrance Municipal Airport plant.

The "Derringer" will sell for \$27,500, and is expected to be available early in 1964.

George S. Wing, president of Hi-Shear Corp., is director of the "Derringer" program.

The new plane features a tilt-up canopy and 360 degree visibility from the cockpit. The plane may be entered from either side. Dual seating and controls are also included on production models. There is

also a 22 cubic foot baggage compartment.

The "Derringer" is designed to meet the needs of today's private air traveller, reports Wing. It can be owned and operated for about 11 cents per air mile with an annual utilization of 600 hours.

Sales will be through a direct factory-dealer organization, and dealer inquiries are invited.
